- Containers are set up in the item file to secure the benefits of inventory replenishment management of containers
- Other TakeStock programs automatically update the status as containers are processed
- Containers can be flagged as returnable or non-returnable for both customer and vendor
- Default customer deposit and vendor deposit amounts can be maintained by container
- Default container due days can be specified for sales to customer and receipt from vendor
